Teachers

Do not stand on chairs or tables to attach wall displays. Take the time to find and use a step stool. Standing on chairs or tables can result in a serious accident.

Coaches

Remember you're a coach, not a player. Save yourself a broken bone or twisted ankle – do not engage in contact sports with students.

Custodians

Take care of your back. Lift with your legs and be willing to ask for help. Watch your step when stripping and waxing floors. Slip and fall injuries are a major injury exposure for you.

Bus Drivers

You have an enormous responsibility for those riding with you. Please obey all traffic laws and be careful getting on and off the bus. Those steps can be tricky. Also remember – no cell phones – talking or texting!

Cafeteria Workers

Slips and falls are a major source of injury for your profession. Proper footwear is essential. Floor clean-up is one primary control along with eliminating any ice build-up in freezers.

If you are injured at work, immediately report the injury or incident to your supervisor or manager. If you need outside medical attention, you will be directed to the medical clinic designated by your employer. Your employer should investigate all accidents. What happened and why? Your employer should make any necessary changes to prevent another such injury. Follow your employer's safe work practices and use your own common sense to avoid accidents. If you see any unsafe condition, report it to management.
